The Community Resource Center (CRC) now has 45 students taking private piano lessons, who earn an electronic keyboard by completing the course and \$20. It also has 11 ESL students twice a week. New classes now include sewing, with 8 students, Art and Employment Skills classes have also started. More are welcome!





On Thursday, 2/8, the My Hometown Youth Council organized 130 youth and leaders in a "Share the Warmth" Service Project, making 83 quilts and blankets for Homeless. My Hometown provided the materials, refreshments.and use of the CRC at 934 W. Fremont Ave.





All 45 of the My Hometown volunteers assist at different times, along with many others from the community in the Food Bank distributions which occur on Wednesday afternoons at the site of the CRC, 934 Fremont Avenue, also known as the Cannon Stake Center.





Under the direction of Mountain View Elementary School Principal Jason Finch, My Hometown volunteers Eliot and Bethany Brinton are organizing senior volunteers to tutor students with reading progress. 22 have volunteered, and more are coming! My Hometown hopes to have more volunteers helping in more schools.
